WYF TACKLE & ROOKIE TEAMS COMPETE IN THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE (FCFL)

- Wilton has a long tradition of competing in the FCFL we are one of the founding towns (5).
- The FCFL is a development league whose top two (2) focuses are <u>player safety</u> and <u>skill development</u>.
- The FCFL rules are unique to Fairfield County.
- The FCFL does not play by classic Pop Warner (or other youth football) rules.
 - > For example: There are no kickoffs, returned punts, or onside kicks in the FCFL.
- The FCFL follows USA Football's 'Heads Up' philosophy, considered a 'Gold Standard' nationally for player safety and skill development.

COMMITMENT, EXPECTATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- WYF Tackle & Rookie players are encouraged to have a <u>primary</u> Fall sport that takes priority and are required to communicate any potential practice/game conflicts with their coaches upfront. This helps with planning for the season.
- <u>Clear communication</u> from coaches and parents/players at the beginning of the season is critical for the success and safety of the whole team.
- <u>Game play</u>: WYF coaches use their best judgement with regards to each player's readiness and safety at positions and time on the field.
- Generally, at each grade level, there are three (3) weekly practices and one (1) game each weekend
- Being on time and non-disruptive in practices is the primary ask of players. Our coaches understand each child progresses at different speeds.

ROOKIE FOOTBALL PROGRAM INFO

- In 2019 the FCFL introduced Rookie Football for grades 2* 4. Enrollment in Football tripled within the towns that participated.
- Rookie Football focuses on all the skills of Tackle Football with full pads and contact however there is no tackling. A player is considered down when a flag is pulled.
- The dramatic success and rapid growth associated with this FCFL program can be attributed to two things:
 - **1. Coaches** The game is made simpler for coaching purposes
 - 2. Players More time is dedicated to teaching important skills, such as blocking
